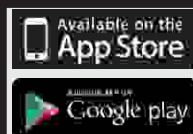

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### 1. What is Lasik?

Lasik (LASER IN SITU KERATO-MILEUSIS) is an advanced laser technique that permanently eliminates your dependence on corrective eyewear i.e. glasses/contact lenses with the resultant lifestyle advantages.

### 2. Is the procedure painful? How long dose it take?

The procedure is painless; some sensation of pressure may be experienced during the creation of the flap. No sedation, no eye pad, no injection is required, only eye drop anesthesia is given. It takes around 10 mins for one eye.

### 3. When can I see after Lasik?

The recovery of vision following LASIK is rapid. One can resume normal activities after 24hrs to 48hrs. No physical, visual or dietary restrictions are necessary.

### 4. How long do I need to be off work?

Generally you can resume work after 48hrs. However, for people working in a dusty environment or those working extensively on computer screens it is prudent to take rest for few more days.

### 5. Upto what number can LASIK correct?

A wide range of refractive errors can be corrected including near sightedness, far sightedness & astigmatism. Near-sightedness (Minus number) 0 to -12 diopter Far-sightedness (Plus number) 0 to +5 diopter. Astigmatism (Cylindrical) 0 to  $\pm 6$  diopter cyl, provided the other parameters of the eye are normal and adequate.

### 6. How successful is this procedure?

In the overwhelming majority of people (more than 96%), LASIK is completely successful in avoiding the need for the glasses.

### 7. Will my eyes be patched?

No, but clear, protective eye shields will be placed over your treated eye (s) following the treatment, and will be removed after checkup. You will continue to wear these eye shields at bedtime for 1 week for protection.



### 8. When can I resume my normal activities?

If you have had LASIK procedure, you can return to work after 2 days. Eye medications should be continued during working hours as instructed by the surgeon. Care should also be taken to avoid any trauma to the eye including rubbing of the eyes during this period.

### 9. How many times do I need to be seen by the Doctor following the treatment?

Most patients are usually seen the day following the treatment and then at least 1 week and 1 month following the treatment. Some patients require more visits.

### 10. What is blade less LASIK/FEMTO LASIK?

It is procedure where a more precise laser beam is used to create a flap.

**Advantage:-** FEMTO LASIK is more precise, predictable, safe and superior procedure compared to microkeratoure LASIK..
